## REACH & RoHS Declaration of Compliance

Dear Sir or Madam, dear Customer,  
We, the Habia Group, consisting of the companies

**HEW Kabel GmbH, Klingsiepen 12, 51688 Wipperfürth, Germany**

**Habia Cable AB, Kanalvägen 16, 194 05 Upplands Väsby, Sweden**

would hereby like to provide you with a comprehensive declaration of our compliance with the relevant chemical and environmental regulations. Our products, materials and components meet the legal requirements and quality standards stipulated by European regulations.

### 1. REACH Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006

We confirm to the best of our knowledge and belief that our products currently do not contain any substances listed in the current SVHC candidate list (Substances of Very High Concern) according to Article 59 of the REACH Regulation in concentrations above 0.1 percent by weight nor any substances listed in Annex XIV or Annex XVII. This declaration is based on information provided to us by our suppliers and our own audits.

According to our own assessment, our products fall under the term 'article' within the meaning of the REACH Regulation and therefore do not require registration with the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in Helsinki. This assessment is based on the current product composition and the applicable principles of interpretation.

In accordance with Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, we inform our customers immediately if a product contains SVHC substances above 0.1% and provide the necessary information.

We work closely with our suppliers to ensure that these commitments are met on an ongoing basis and are regularly reviewed.

The classification and assessment of the substances used is carried out taking into account the criteria in Annex XIII of the REACH Regulation and the CLP Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008, including substances classified as:

- carcinogenic (category 1 or 2)
- mutagenic (category 1 or 2)
- toxic for reproduction (category 1 or 2).

## 2. RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU

Those products of our Group which fall within the scope of Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II) and the amending regulations (EU) 2015/863 and (EU) 2018/2005 comply with the requirements of these regulations. These regulations restrict the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

This applies in particular to the following substances, the maximum concentration of which must not be exceeded in homogeneous materials: lead (Pb), mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd), hexavalent chromium (Cr<sup>6+</sup>), polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP).

Regulation (EU) 2018/2005 extends the existing list of substances to include the four phthalates mentioned (DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP), which have also been subject to the restrictions of the RoHS Directive since 22 July 2019.

We confirm to the best of our knowledge and belief that the products of our Group that fall within the scope of the RoHS Directives comply with the limit values for these substances laid down in Annex II of Directive (EU) 2015/863 in conjunction with Regulation (EU) 2018/2005 and are therefore RoHS compliant. This declaration is based on current information from our suppliers and our internal audits.

Furthermore, we confirm that the products of our Group intended for the Chinese market do not contain any substances restricted by the law SJ/T 11363-2006 (China RoHS), comparable to EU Directive 2011/65/EU.

## 3. IMDS and GADSL

To meet the specific requirements of the automotive industry, we ensure, via the International Material Data System (IMDS), that, to the best of our knowledge and belief, all products and materials supplied by us are fully and correctly documented.

By providing the relevant material data sheets, we ensure that, according to our current knowledge, the prohibited substances listed in the Global Automotive Declarable Substance List (GADSL) are not used in our products.

At the same time, we ensure that all substances requiring declaration under GADSL are properly disclosed to our automotive industry customers as soon as possible and provided we have received relevant information from our suppliers.

#### 4. Disclaimer and limitations

This declaration is based on the information we have received from our suppliers, as well as on regular internal audits and assessments. We assume no liability for the accuracy, completeness and timeliness of the information provided by our suppliers.

Should any changes occur that affect the conformity of our products, we will inform you immediately. We exclude liability for damages caused by incomplete or incorrect information from our suppliers, unless we are guilty of gross negligence or intent.

This declaration is valid only at the time of its issuance and does not constitute a guarantee for the future. The customer is responsible for independently verifying the suitability of our products for their intended purpose.
